Memberships and fees

The Model Constitution under the Associations Incorporation Act 2009 defines members of the association.

As noted in the Model Constitution a fee will be determined as a membership fee by the committee (currently \$77 at 15/7/ 2023 – proposed \$99 from 1/1/2024 to be reviewed annually by committee).

The Committee may approve a pro rata (or similar) credit for memberships that are not a full year.

Enterprise Membership

This by law defines an “enterprise membership”

To accommodate multi-person businesses an “enterprise membership” will be charged at a higher rate (proposed \$249 from 1/1/2023 to be reviewed annually by committee).

Enterprise membership will provide one voting member benefit to an individual in the business and allow member price tickets to events for up to 5 members of that enterprise (i.e. employees of that business).

“enterprise member” will be recognised as such in the member listing section of the website.
